Building a seine net

Materials:

- Some fiberglass window screening; at least 2'x4'
- Two 30" wooden dowels (an old broom handle works fine) or small scrap lumber, about 4-6 inches longer than the screen is wide

Tools:

- Carpenter's staplegun
- Scissors
- Hand saw

Instructions:

- 1. Cut the screen to be about 2' wide by 4' long.
- 2. Cut the handles to be about 30" long, about 6 inches longer than the screen is wide.
- 3. Roll out the screen and place the handles on top, making sure that one of the ends is even with the bottom of the screen.
- 4. Wrap the screen around the handle, just so that the screen is on top.
- 5. Staple the screen to the handles, starting just off the bottom of each stick and working to the top of the screen, putting in a staple every couple of inches.
- 6. Roll the screen around the sticks working both sides at the same time to carry or store the net.
